## Sock It To 'Em Sock Drive!

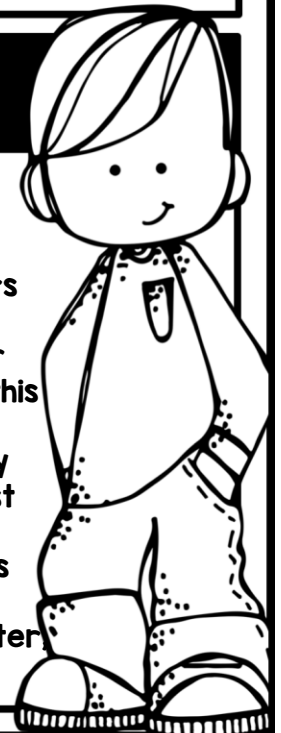
**NO MORE COLD FEET!**

Long Beach local, Justin Rudd and his Community Action Team hold an annual collection of new pairs of socks in January with a goal to collect 14,000 pairs for area homeless men, women and youth.

Lakewood Village Nursery School has been participating in this program for several years and has collected more than 500 pairs of new socks during this Sock Donation Drive.

How many pairs can you commit to? As little as 4 pairs of socks per family will help us easily reach our goal! Black or white athletic socks are the most requested and preferred.

Socks will be distributed to homeless living in the streets, parks, and in tents along the LA River. Socks will also be donated to homeless school kids, Christian Outreach in Action, Long Beach Rescue Mission, Multi Services Center MHA Village, and other homeless services providers. Thank you!
